Completion of the **Leadership Journey** cohort provides an opportunity to earn three graduate level credits through Northwest University. We meet quarterly at the Network Office for a full day of teaching, team interaction, and networking. Sessions provide both spiritual formation and practical ministry and leadership development. The final session takes place as a 3-day, 3-night culminating retreat experience, which includes a 24-hour prayer retreat.
